## Introduction

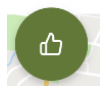
The '**BART Street**' Pilot is an initiative that originated from a partnership between BART Solutions and the Roleystone Volunteer Fire & Rescue Service.

The Roleystone VFRS saw potential in the BART system to assist with their Bushfire Ready Program in Western Australia. The initial trial utilised BART as a digital 'Fire Tree' to communicate critical information to local residents.

Roleystone have been proactive in educating both Residents and Street Coordinators, which has helped ensure the success of the trial.

The BART Team are now extending this trial out to other vulnerable communities across Australia and New Zealand, and have named the project '**BART Street Pilot**'.




**The Principle Function of BART Street** is that you as a Resident will receive messages and you respond by pressing the



## Green Thumbs Up button

to indicate that you, the Street Coordinator and others Residents in your street know that you have received the message.

The next very important function is that when you receive an **Evacuation Message** you have the option to respond as follows:

- (1)  **Green Thumbs Up** – You are leaving to a safe place
- (2)  **Red Thumbs Down** – You are NOT LEAVING
- (3)  **Yellow Other** – You require assistance

No response by you will indicate to the Street Coordinator and other Residents in your street that you have not received the message.

## Costs Involved

The BART Street Pilot will be provided free of charge from November 2024 to February 2025, for a limited number of participants. This includes all Residents, Street Coordinators, and the managing Brigade, Unit, or Committee.

SMS credits will also be provided at no cost for Residents during this period.

## Terms and Conditions

To join the BART Street Pilot, we first require your registration and authorisation to the terms and conditions outlined below.

### **Please Note:**

The BART Street is only a secondary information source, where communications provided by the State and Emergency Agencies must always take priority.

Street Coordinators and Residents **must not rely solely** on messaging on BART to act upon any current or unfolding emergency.

All Street Coordinators and Residents will be required to provide:

- Full Name
- Mobile number
- Email Address (optional)

### **Street Coordinators and Residents will only have access to the designated Street or Local Area.**

Participating members are to abide by the following Community Terms of Use.

### **Any of the following is prohibited within BART Street:**

- a. Violent, obscene, profane, hateful, derogatory, racist or sexist language
- b. Discussion or promotion of behaviour that is unlawful
- c. Comments that threaten or defame any person or organization
- d. Solicitations, advertisements or endorsements without prior approval
- e. Encouragement or glamorization of the use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs
- f. Hyperlinks to any of the above material
- g. Multiple successive irrelevant or spam comments

If a participating member is found to have undertaken any of the points outlined in the prohibited activities, the BART Team may take the following actions depending on the severity of the offending:

- a. Written or verbal notification of unacceptable behaviour
- b. Suspension of Member's account
- c. Close the Member's account.

People who do not physically live in a street within BART Street or have moved, the Street Coordinator will remove the Resident from BART Street.

BART Street is currently being run as a Pilot by Volunteers so the brigade, unit or committee cannot guarantee a message will be sent every time.

Fire is unpredictable so it is essential that you have a fire plan, DO NOT rely on a message from BART Street. Fires can escalate rapidly and without warning.

Maintain your own situational awareness and action your own fire plan as required.
